RE: **TRANSPORTING PROHIBITED ITEMS: WAC 392-145-021**

Principals: Please share this information with all teachers at a faculty meeting and feel free to add it in your Student Handbook.

Bus Drivers: Please read this to the students on your bus.

Heavy, sharp, bulky and/or other articles, which may be hazardous in the event of an accident or emergency stop, shall not be transported in the passenger area of any school bus. Specific attention is directed to items such as skis, ski poles, vaulting poles, musical instruments, riser platforms, etc.

Teachers and all other school district staff shall refrain from requesting students to transport prohibited items between home and school on a school bus. Items, which shall not be transported within the passenger area of a school bus, also include all forms of animal life (except service animals), firearms, weapons, breakable containers, flammables, and all other articles that could adversely affect the safety of the bus and passengers.

The following is a partial list of items **NOT** allowed:

Aquariums	Glass jars	Weapons
Large musical Instruments	Risers	Squirt guns
Toothpick sculpture	Suckers with sticks	Spiked athletic shoes (may be secured in bag)
Loud radios	Balloons (helium or otherwise)	Pins (straight)
Laser lights	Animals (except service animals)	Baseball bats
Golf clubs	Aerosol cans/perfume	Basketball (may be secured in bag)
Anything that can break into dangerous fragments	Scooters	Chemicals (including Mace-type substances)
Trench Coats	Skateboards
