

Memorandum: WSU/Clark Center/iTech Prep Parking lot Congestion

Problem Identified:

Increasing numbers of vehicles waiting at WSU/Clark Center to drop off or pickup iTech Prep students are causing safety concerns and congestion in parking lots and driveways surrounding the Clark Center.

Parking rules and iTech specific parking plan regarding drop-off and pickup:

- Parking at WSU Vancouver (and Clark Center) is mandated, regulated and enforced according to WAC 504-19. WSU Vancouver Police and Parking Services actively enforce parking and traffic statutes to maintain safety and equity, and to manage parking on campus.
- All vehicles parking on WSU Vancouver property are required to park in an available marked parking space. Use of ADA, Reserved, or specially marked parking spaces requires a specific parking permit available at WSU Parking Services. parkingservices@vancouver.wsu.edu
- Vehicles are specifically prohibited from parking or standing at curbs, driveways and all areas not marked for parking.
- All vehicles parked on WSU Vancouver Property must display proof of payment for parking (parking permit, meter payment, parking lot receipt).

iTech Specific parking consideration:

- Drivers waiting to drop off or pick up iTech Preparatory students may not park, stand, or block any curb, driveway, roadway, or crosswalk at any time.
- Drivers waiting for drop-off or pickup **MAY orbit in roadways with consideration for speed, safety, and congestion.**
- Drivers waiting for drop-off or pickup **MAY park without payment in any available regularly marked parking space and wait in their occupied vehicle until the student enters or exits the building during the periods: 9:00-9:45AM and 3:45-4:30PM only.** Suggested parking lots are highlighted on the attached campus map.
- All unattended parked vehicles must display payment for parking. Unattended vehicles without a valid permit or parking payment will be issued citations.

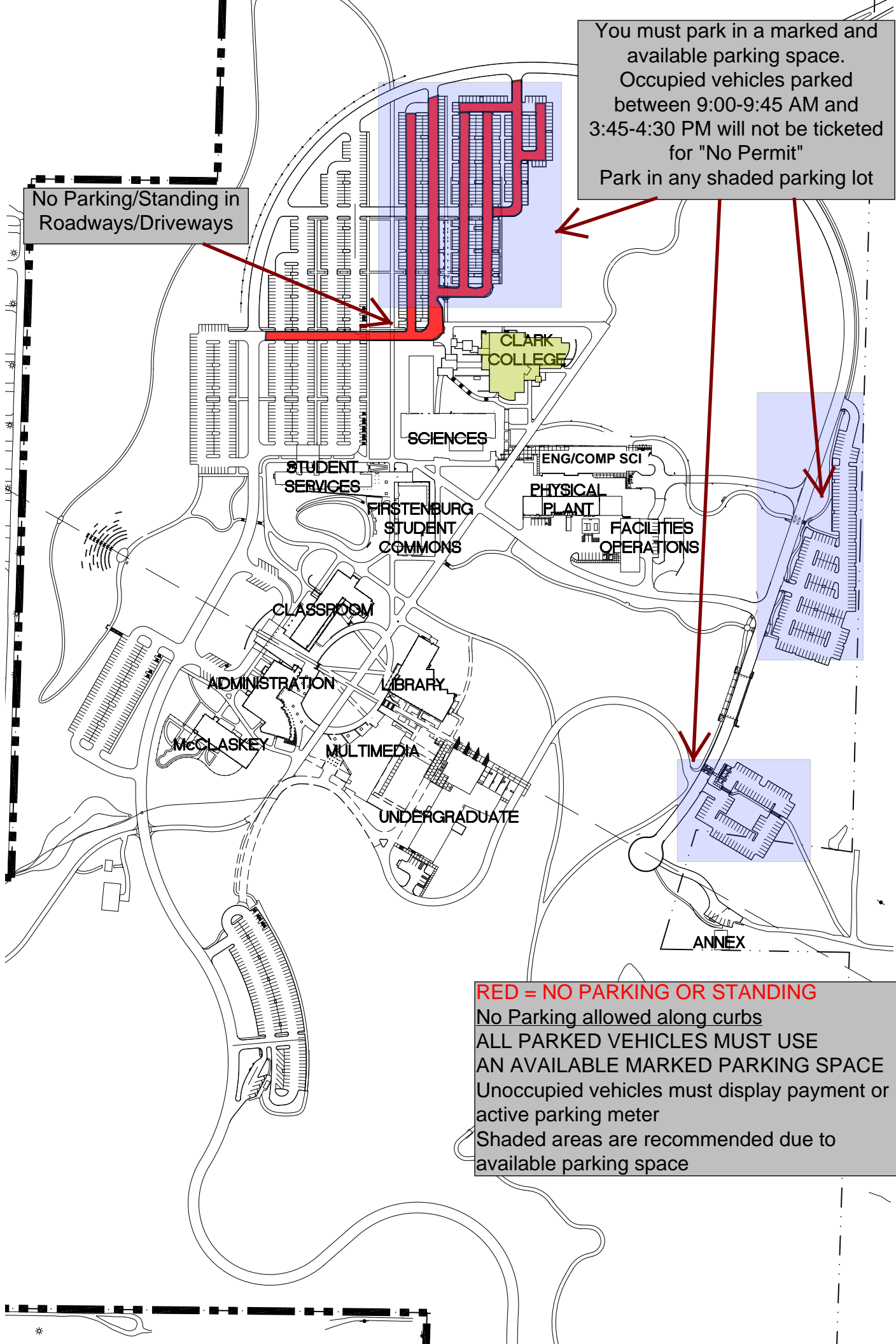
WSU Vancouver Police and Parking Services will actively patrol and enforce traffic and parking regulations to assure safety and compliance with traffic and parking regulations.
