STEP #1: CREATE AN ESSENTIAL QUESTION

- What do you already know about your topic? What do you want to learn?
- Create an **unbiased** question based on what you wonder in order to guide your research.

EXAMPLES: What role does technology play in war? How has US military equipment given American soldiers an advantage in combat? What specific failures in technology have created disadvantages for soldiers?

STEP #2: RESEARCH YOUR ESSENTIAL QUESTION (EQ)

Using research databases, find answers to your **EQ**.

EXAMPLE: My research of military equipment used by the US **Naval** forces in the **21st Century** suggests that...

(Notice that your research will create a more detailed analysis, thus narrowing your focus.)

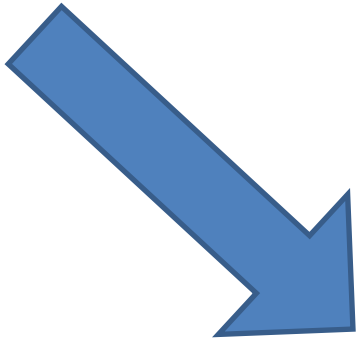
STEP #3: MAKE A CLAIM BASED ON RESEARCH

After researching your **EQ**, make a **biased CLAIM** & **persuade** the reader about the impact of your invention; a product that will save the day, solve the issue, rise above competitors & help you earn the \$ BIG BUCKS \$.

EQ RESEARCH: My research of US Naval military equipment...suggests that...

CLAIM: The US government has unethically put Navy soldiers in extraneous danger by providing defective military equipment. My product uses cutting edge technology to combat this unnecessary & negligent oversight by...

At this point in the research process, you should also be looking at Part 2 of the *iPrize* Worksheet-PRODUCT RESEARCH.



STEP #4: SUPPORT YOUR CLAIM WITH EVIDENCE

After clearly articulating your **CLAIM**, communicate **5** pieces of evidence that will enhance your credibility to consumers.

CLAIM: My product uses cutting edge technology to combat this unnecessary & negligent oversight by...
