Young Champions Student Athlete Heart Screenings use cardiac ultrasound and EKG tests to spot a serious heart condition known to cause sudden cardiac death in active teens. The screening program is sponsored by PeaceHealth Southwest Heart & Vascular Center and the Quinn Driscoll Foundation.

How do I sign up my child?

What is the cost:

This special Saturday event is Free with a suggested, donation of \$25 for the Quinn Driscoll Foundation Teen Screenings are also available during the Adult weekly clinic for a fee of \$50.

Who is eligible?

Any middle or high school student, athlete, band member or cheerleader from 12 – 18 years old is eligible for a Young Champions screening. Although designed for the student athlete, this screening offer also accommodates all children in the age group who may be at risk. This screening does not take the place of the pre-performance examination requirement for all student athletes who wish to participate in a school sport.

Young Champions Student Athlete Screenings include:

- Review of child's personal and family health history
- Blood pressure
- ECG/EKG (electrocardiogram)
- Echocardiogram (heart ultrasound)
