

Columbia River Band Uniform Contract

2010 - 2011

The Columbia River Band Uniform identifies our band as representatives of our school and community. Band uniforms will be issued to students that perform in scheduled performances that require the uniform or part of the uniform. For example, pep band performances, community events and parades.

All uniforms will be kept at the school. Students will dress in their assigned uniform before a performance, and must return their uniform after each performance. This system of uniform tracking reduces the amount of lost items that need replacement each year. If a special need occurs and a student cannot be present for uniform pick up or return, it is the student's responsibility to make arrangements with the instructor prior to the day of performance. Any uniform part that is not returned will result in an appropriate bill being issued to the student. Damage to any uniform due to neglect or failure to follow guidelines will result in students being charged to replace those items. Approximate replacement costs for the 2010-2011 school year are as follows:

Coat (Purple & black w/ gold buttons)	\$250.00
Trouser	\$200.00
Cape (Drum Majors)	\$100.00
Shako (Hat)	\$50.00
Shako Hat Box	\$15.00
Beret	\$12.00
Plume	\$30.00
Gloves	\$7.00
Garment Bag	\$15.00
Nylon Jacket	\$49.99

Parents and students need to allow appropriate time before and after each performance, for uniforms to be checked out to students and rechecked back in. All items of the uniform will be checked when a student returns the uniform after a performance. Students are responsible for hanging their uniforms up correctly in their garment bags, and returning uniform pieces in their proper places in the garment bags and hat boxes. If any item of a student's uniform requires repair or replacement during the school year, it is the student's responsibility to inform the instructor or uniform coordinator immediately so the uniform may be corrected.
