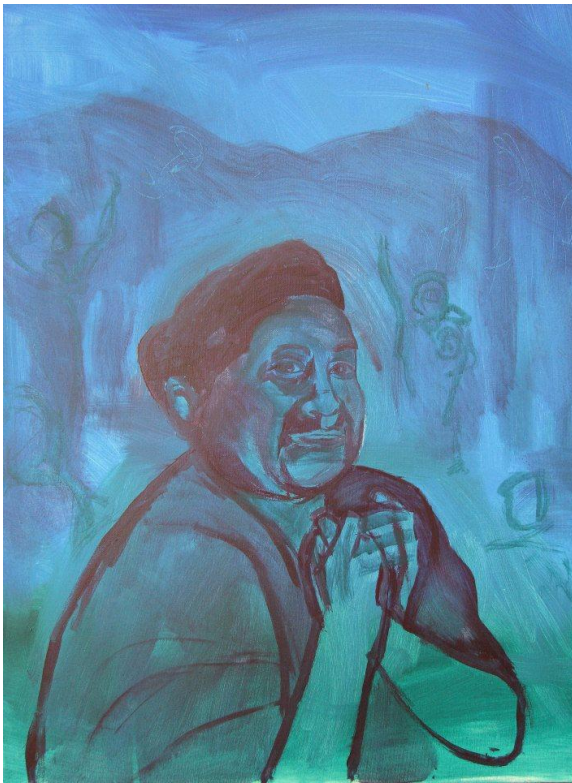
I know and understand how to apply at least 6 different color schemes

Create crisp edges, Create a variety of textures: scratching, impasto, dry brush

And Create layers: wash, glazing

- Studio Focus: Silent study first 20 minutes

## Practice Painting #1 criteria

- Level 2:
  - Use white canvas board
  - Use mono-chromatic color scheme
  - Draw contour lines with white charcoal
- Level 3:
  - Use larger white canvas board or reclaimed canvas board
  - Use a limited color palette in chosen color scheme
  - Draw contour lines with washes of paint only
- **Develop a full value range:** White or almost white tints/highlights, and Black or almost black shades
- Use cool colors and/or neutral colors in background to **show depth**
- **Utilize at least 2 of the 4 techniques from your practice through out your painting**
