	firmly into center of bat, pat at 45 deg. Angle, and how to <b>Cone</b> and <b>Dome</b> Properly. Shannon
	When I <b>cone</b> , I have a hard time making the clay come up quickly, maybe if I adjust
	the pressure of my hands and squeeze into the clay more at a 45 degree angle it would help.
	When I dome the clay usually makes a mushroom shape instead of a dome, if I try Shannons'
	hand placements it will help make more of a dome shape.
