







Graphic Design: Self Portrait in the style of Andy Warhol

<u>Creative Problem:</u> How can you capture your personality using facial expression and bold color combinations inspired by the work of Pop Artist Andy Warhol?

<u>Visual Journal Assignment:</u>

- Brainstorm and reflect on the expression you would like to capture in your self portrait..... what kind of angle? Expression? Background or props?
- Collect visual research of some of Andy Warhol's designs that you find particularly intriguing...look at use of bold color....
- Take multiple pictures using 'photo booth' or the digital camera if you need a more specific background

Project Criteria:

Imagery: Follow the steps in the tutorial to 'Warholize' your chosen image. Create a minimum of four smaller images on one page, each with a different color combination.

Photoshop Tools and Techniques you will be practicing:

- Channel Mixer
- Posterize
- Magic wand- Anti-Alias and contiguous settings
- Color sampler tool

Design: Elements and Principles Arrange your finished 'Warholized' images in such a way that the overall composition has a sense of balance, and movement. (not all the warm toned images are next to each other, etc.)
